Congratulations to Halton and Frodsham Harrier, JADE CARR, who recently returned from the European Heart and Lung Transplant Games, held in Vichy, France. Jade, who is only 14, competed in the Senior age Group (18-20) returning with a fistful of medals. She won Gold in the 100m (15.3), Gold in the Long Jump (3.33m) and Bronze in the 4x100m relay; after taking the baton in last place she produced a blistering leg to bring the team home in Bronze position. Demonstrating her all-round versatility, Jade also won Gold medals in Badminton Singles and Doubles Events, and wrapped up her medal haul with a win in the Table Tennis Singles. Her globetrotting days are not over, as she has already been invited to compete in the World Transplant Games in Australia in 2009. Hopefully she will be as successful as she was last year, when she returned from Thailand with a Gold and a Silver.

(Also, noticed in today's Athletics weekly was that Darren Scott won the European Masters M35 200m title and he is hoping to break the World Masters 200m record next year when he moves up an age group).
