2010 Cheshire road running GP

The Cheshire AA committee have agreed to fund the prizes for the Cheshire RR GP series in 2010 at the same level as the previous 2 years (just over £1000 in prizes).

Adrian Thiemicke is processing the responses from Cheshire clubs before announcing the events to be included in the GP series. So far only about half of the clubs have responded to his e-mail requests for suggestions.

Road relay results

The traditional National road relays in Sutton Park, Sutton Coldfield produced some medals for a Cheshire club. The Under 13 girls team from Warrington AC finished second just 6 seconds behind Aldershot F&D who won all the female age group relays. Carys McAulay of Warrington ran the 8th fastest leg of all, while Jess Parsons of Vale Royal ran the second fastest leg of all when bringing her team in at the end of the first leg.

Leading Cheshire clubs in the other events were Vale Royal 12th in the under 15 girls and 8th in the Under 17 womens event. In the boys events Warrington's under 13 Boys team were 15th with Liam Burthem running the 10th equal fastest leg of all runners in that event. There was a close finish between 3 cheshire club teams in the Under 15 boys with Vale Royal "B" 20th, Warrington 21st and Vale Royal "A" 23rd. Warrington's "A" team was 18th in the Under 17 Men's event.

The previous day, Warrington's Men's and ladies teams took part in the senior events, as did Vale Royal's men's team. Most runners in these teams were Juniors which looks promising for the future.

Although no medals this year, there were some good team and individual performances at Mansfield in an increasingly popular event. Warrington were 11th in the under 13 girls event for whom E Smith ran the 10th fastest leg of all in the event, while Jess Parsons of Vale Royal ran the 2nd fastest leg overall.

Warrington U13 Boys team finished 8th, with Liam Burthem 10th fastest, while M Sheen of Vale Royal was 4th fastest.

In the Under 15 girls event, Vale Royal were 7th, while their U17 womens team were 10th with Megan Huxley 10th fastest and their U20 team 5th with Rebecca Craigie 9th fastest. The Warrington U20 Mens team were also 5th with 3 very consistent legs.

At senior level, Macclesfield took part in both the Mens and womens relays, while Warrington and Vale Royal also ran in the Mens event.

Representative Honours- Cross Country.

Congratulations to Harry Ellis and Louisa Wood, both of Warrington AC on gaining selection for representative teams in cross country events. Harry has been selected to compete in the England under 20 team in the UK Cross Challenge at Gateshead on 14 November. Louisa has been selected for the North of England senior ladies team in the Tilberg International cross country meeting on 21st November.

- A National Schools Championships medal
- An U17, U20 or U23 Championships medal
- An international representative
- In the top six of the appropriate UK ranking lists for event and age group.
