Congratulations also to Olivia Walwyn of Altrincham who will join the England team for the Commonwealth Mountain Running Championships at Keswick, on 20 September.

On 29 June, there were medals and great results for England's young mountain running athletes. Great Britain and N Ireland took boys and girls teams to the 4th International Youth Challenge. The race, held over 5km for boys and 3km for girls was run over a tough 1km lapped course which consisted of a steep climb from the start of 80 metres and then took the athletes down a difficult descent which included steps and sharp turns.
