CONGRATULATIONS to Stuart Doyle of Vale Royal AC, Tom McGaff of Wilmslow RC and Rob Tudor of West Cheshire AC who gained national vests representing England at the British and Irish Masters International X-C Championships, held at Glasgow on 26 November. Stuart was first English finisher in the Over 40 age group leading England to a team victory; Tom was third English counter for the Over 55 team who also won, while Rob was 7th English finisher in the Over 45 age group who also won the team race.

The final endurance relays of the Autumn were the English National Cross Country event at Mansfield. There was success again for teams from Cheshire clubs:

Vale Royal U15 Girls team picked up silver medals only 5 seconds behind the winners with K Gerrard running the 7th fastest leg. Vale Royal also finished 5th team in both the U15 Boys and U17 Womens events, while in the U13 Boys their team finished 10th and 11th in the Under 20 women's event. Warrington AC teams finished 8th in the U15 Boys event and 15th in the U15 Girls.
