 member of a very strong Northern contingent who travelled with their England

 colleagues. They were taking part in round 6 of the eight-round Lotto Cup.

At the **English Cross Country Championships** on 25th February at an unusually dry and warm Parliament Fields on Hampstead Heath, north London there were successes and good performances for Cheshire clubs. Congratulations to the Under 15 Girls team of Harriet Knowles-Jones (11th), E Smith, K Merrell and H Tidds from Warrington AC who finished in 2nd place. Best placed Cheshire runner in this race was K Gerrard of Vale Royal who was 9th leading her team to 11th place. Vale Royal finished 5th place teams in the Under 17 Women's and Under 15 Boys events. Individually E Bowker was 6th and M Sheen 15th for VR in the U15 race and Ameilia Pettitt 16th for VR in the U17 Women's event. At Senior level Stevie Stockton (Vale Royal) had an excellent run for 8th place with Olivier Walwyn Bush (City of Norwich), but qualified for Cheshire, was 17th. In the Senior Men's event, Matt Barnes of Altrincham was 22nd and Danny Cliffe (Liverpool) 34th, both qualified for Cheshire.

We wish all the Cheshire teams good running in the Inter-County Championships at Cofton Park on Saturday, 10th March.

Cheshire's under 13 boys team finished third in a very strong group at the inter counties final at Wigan on 25 February. The under 13 & under 15 girls together with the under 15 boys finished first and will go on to represent the northwest at the UK final at Birmingham on 21 April. Cheshire's under 15 girls dominated the competition, taking the first three places in the all-rounder event with Freya Taylor-Hatswell (C&N), Emily Ball (WC) and Annie Huntbach (C&N). Not to be outdone, Cheshire also featured in the boys' all-rounder event with Matthew Pagan (WC) and Joe Terry (C&N) tying for second.

Two weeks earlier the northwest league finals were held, also at Wigan. Crewe and Nantwich took first places in the U11 and U13 boys and the U15 girls. West Cheshire were winners in the U13 girls and U15 boys, with Wirral taking first in the U11 girls.
