Ray Eagle, an endurance runner with Wilmslow Running Club was sadly killed in a plane crash in Nepal along with a number of others in late September. Ray was an accomplished distance runner and held the Cheshire all-time best performance for the marathon for the M55 age group which he set in 2011. Ray ran for Wilmslow in the NW relays at Marbury Park, shortly before travelling to Nepal.

JOHN LAWTON

John Lawton, a noted long distance runner with Sandbach Striders disappeared while competing in a tough Mountain Marathon race in Greece in April. Despite a number of searches, his body was not found until mid August some way from the expected route between check points.
