Mike Hancock

Mike Hancock, a former geography teacher at Neston High School on the Wirral, was well known in the Cheshire area and wider for his involvement over many years in coaching athletes. Although not an active athlete himself he had a great interest in the sport and was very popular with the school and club athletes he brought through and encouraged to perform well, many to a high

Sadly Mike died just before Christmas after a battle with cancer, but was still actively coaching and supporting athletes until a short time before he died. Hopefully he will have got to know about one of his recent group of athletes, Katie Brough and her excellent performance in Spain (reported below). Mike's funeral is on Tuesday, 8th January at 10:30am at St Mary's & St Helen's Church in the centre of Neston and later at the Blacon Crematorium, Chester.
