## Cheshire Track Relays – a Request to Cheshire Clubs

The Cheshire committee have reviewed the 2014 track relay championships. While the committee were grateful to Warrington AC for hosting and dealing with entries, they were disappointed at the low level of entries and that some Cheshire clubs, particularly those with young athletes, chose not to enter any teams. Some events did not take place due to no entries while for some other events only entries from guest teams were received.

The committee is aware that the move to two mid-week evenings rather than a full single day at a weekend was a major change, but was unable to find a free weekend day. That situation is unlikely to change in future years.

The committee request the views of Cheshire clubs on NOT holding the event in 2015. ### Northern Athletics Road Relays, Birchwood, 20 September.

In the Men's event with over 150 teams starting, Vale Royal were 11th with Elliot Bowker running the 5th fastest leg for the 6km of all the 700+ runners taking part in this race. Wilmlsow and Spectrum Striders also had complete teams finish along with a Vale Royal B team.

In the ladies event also over 6km legs, Vale Royal were 9th of the 77 teams styarting with Tessa Mccormick runnimng the 6th fastest leg of all runners. Spectrum Striders (who hosted the event for Northern Athletics) also finished a full team along with a Vale Royal B team

In the Under 17 mens race over 3.3km legs Vale Royal were  $5^{th}$  with Jacob Brown running the  $8^{th}$  fastest leg. In the Under 17 womens event Harriet Knowles-Jones ran the fastest leg of all runneres for Warrington wg=ho nwere second team. Vale Royal were  $5^{th}$  team in this event.

In the Under 15 Girls race over 3km legs, Warrington were 7th and in the Boys race were 5th (with Jack Stubbings 6th fastest leg) and Vale Royal 6th (with Arun Dight 7th fastest leg).

Warrington U13 Boys team won the Northern Championship with Sam Evans recording the fastyest leg and Jordan Jones the 7<sup>th</sup> fastest leg.

A Guiness World Record: Father and Son, Graham and Ben Green of Warrington AC have become the Guiness World Record Holders for the fastest combined time for the marathon with their performances in this year's London Marathon. Ben, currently the fastest of Cheshire club runners this year, recorded 2:35:30 and Graham 2:43:05.

Liam Burthem (Warrington AC) was 2<sup>nd</sup> English runner to finish in the International U20 Fell Race at Glendalough, Ireland.

Ann-Marie Jones (Altrincham) was first F60 lady in the World Masters Mountain Running championships in Austria. At the same meeting, Dave Alexander (West Cheshire) was first GB athlete to finish (15th Overall) in the M45 age group.
