Cheshire Age Group Road Running Records

The first 3 moinths have seen a number of age group records for road races broken. Andy Green of Warrington AC has set new M50 times for 5 miles, 10K and half-marathon. His time in the Trafford 10K proved to be a World Best time for a 52 year-old male. Tom McGaff (Wilmslow RC) now a M60 has reduced the 10K record twice and the half-marathon record once, so far. Mick Fairs (M65, Wilmslkow) set a new age group half-marathon record at Wilmlsow

where Stuart Doyle (Vale Royal) lowered his M40 record again. On the ladies side, Rosemary Rogers (West Cheshire) has twice lowered the F65 10K record.

In the **British Masters AF** CC Championships held at Ruthin : Nick Jones was 1st M40, Ian Wetherall (Sale H) was 3rd M45; Colin Bishop (Helsby) 2nd M55. Hasyley Kuter (Salford H) was 2nd F35 and Anne-Marie Jones (Altrincham) was 2nd F60.

Inter-Counties, Cofton Park

Cheshire's Senior Ladies were 10th with T McCormick, K Brough, A Pettitt, S Murphy, A Hildrup and K Titlow.

U13 boys – S Evans was 6^{th} individual and the team finished in 7^{th} place (S Eans, A Bould, J Jones, S Dean).

Junior Man E Bowker had an excellent third place for Cheshire in his race and was selected for the GB & NI Junior Men's team for the World Championships in China where he was 3rd counter in the British Junior team.

Harriet Knowles-Jones of Warrington was also selected to compete for GB & NI juniors at the World Championships in China but was denied the opportunity to compete because of visa difficulties owing to her age. In the Inter-county championships she crossed the finish line in second position in the U20 event but was disqualified for not wearing her timning chip.
