Cheshire Age Group Road Running Records

Several Cheshire age group records were set in recent marathon races. In the Manchester event Nicky Mowat (Wilmlsow) reduced her F55 time by a substantial margin.

In the London race, Graham Green (Warrington AC) set a new M50 record when finishing first in his age group overall and with his son, Ben, alongside enjoyed running over Tower Bridge with no other runners close by. Ben went on to finish almost 2 minutes ahead of his father. Yet to be confirmed, but should be a new Guniess Record for the pair. Matthew Smith (South Cheshire) set a new M40 record, while Colin Rathbone set a new M70 record (third in his age group) and Harry Newton improved on his M75 County record.
