#### Main meeting

- Emergency response courses put on by clubs and open to network members to be promoted through the network and part funded by network.
- Pole Vault after some considerable discussion agreed to buy more training poles. RL in conjunction with Rod Grant Smith.
- Make Off road training days happen. RL / AG to progress chase.
- Level 2 Officials course Network to fund network club attendees.
- Networking through schools and universities still need to decide how this can best be done to our advantage.
- Marketing the network. Make more effective use thro a direct link into the CCAA website using a link through the Cheshire network logo. Also how can we make it live and responsive so that network members can update easily? VH, AG in conjunction with Ashley Pritchard.

### **Year 2 Proposals**

There was insufficient time to debate this properly, but it was felt that there was no reason why we should not be developing further our main themes, of clubs working better together, and development days for PV, hammer, discus, and endurance; as well as adding new events and items.

RL left a hand written proposal for an indoor PV facility at John Deane academy, together with a rough projection of set up costs of £5300 and ongoing annual cost of £2500. This will need to be debated in detail.
