The three recent EA **North West roadshows** were regarded as a success. Many of the attendees were key players at grassroots level and the discussions were excellent. Whatever happens nationally the very fact that people are discussing issues that concern them can only be beneficial. More than anything, the roadshows showed that, irrespective of England Athletics and funding provision, the best way forward for athletics to continue to prosper in the North West is for the counties and the regional council to work together. Various issues relating to the County T&F Championships were discussed – timing and entry dates being two of the issues – but what appears to be clear is that there is a fall-off in entries from Seniors and U20s. The regional championships may redress this but only time will tell. Whatever happens, a strong county structure is crucial hopefully the regional council can assist. The next regional council meeting is 9 June at Stretford when we will be reviewing the NW champs and looking forward to the multi-events/road and cross-country events coming up.
